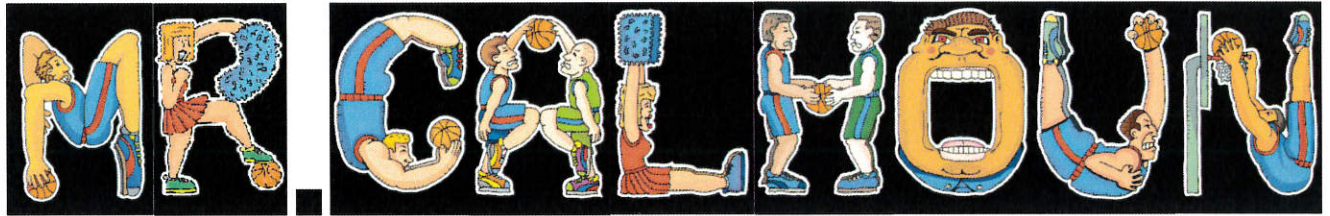

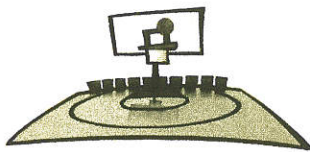

The Fightin Phils will then send your book directly to you within 7 days!

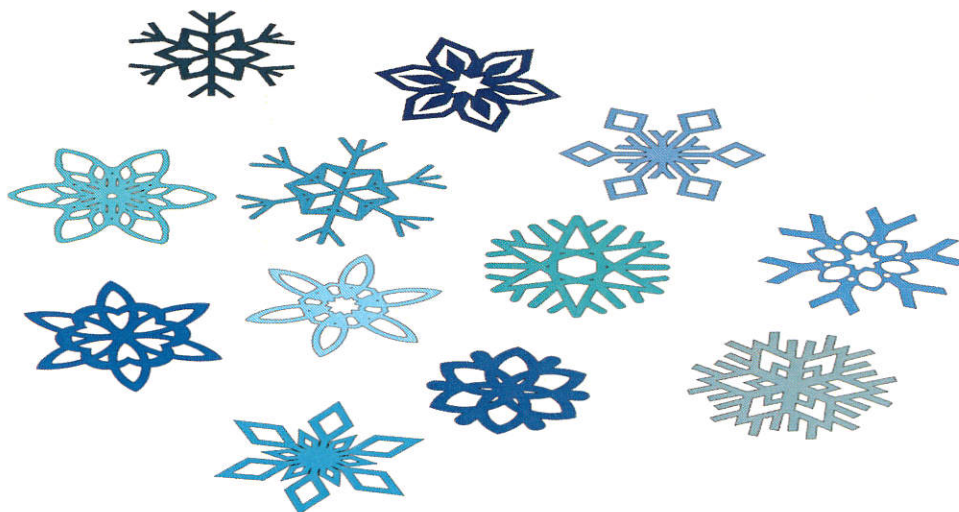


The Nash Box Tops “Snowball Fight” is on!
