

WHAT DO YOU NEED TO BRING THE DAY OF YOUR APPOINTMENT?

- ☑ Proof of residency in the NPSD. A current utility bill, rental agreement or lease, driver's license or other official document showing parent/legal guardian's name and current address.
- ✓ **Proof of birth.** Parent/legal guardian must bring a copy of the child's birth certificate, church record or physician's statement to verify age. Student must be 5 years of age by September 15, 2015.
- ☑ Proof of current immunizations. Written documentation (month, day and year) from a hospital or clinic, physician or previous school immunization record which verifies that your child has received the following immunizations:

K-12	4 doses – 1 dose on or after 4 th birthday	2	3	3	2


