

Principal's News

Dear Nash Families,

Thank you for your patience as we move forward to spring. It has been one crazy winter and I am looking forward to warmer temperatures.

I would like to continue reminding our parents that the school doors will school open at 9:00 AM. We still have a number of students being dropped off at the drop-off line prior to 9:00 AM. For everyone's safety, it is best to drop off when there are staff members present. Staff members are responsible to attend meetings and prep for their classrooms starting at 8:20 and report to their duties at 9:00 AM.

The month of March is an exciting time as we prepare for the PSSA state assessments. Students from grades 3-6 will be assessed on Math and Reading. Grade 4 will take the Science PSSA and our 5th grade will take the PSSA Writing. The testing schedule is as follows:

PSSA Math and Reading

March 25th, 26th, 27th, and 28th April 1st and 2nd

PSSA Writing April 8th, 9th, and 10th

PSSA Science April 29th and 30th

PSSA Make Up Assessments As Needed

As they always do, during PSSA time, the staff will be taking great care of our students. Throughout the week, events like the PSSA Rally and Just Dance Incentive help students understand the importance of balancing hard work with some fun. You can also help by encouraging students to eat their fruits and vegetables, get the appropriate amount of sleep at night, and to be prepared for school each day. When you have a chance, ask your children how they are doing and provide words of encouragement. At the end of our rally, we always remind our students that "We care about you. We are here for you. We know you will do your very best."

March 2nd is Read Across America Day. It is also Dr. Seuss's Birthday. Nash will be celebrating both of these events on our Spirit Day on March 7th. Students can help us celebrate by wearing Dr. Seuss items or by wearing red and white clothing.



NP Adjusted School Days due to Weather

☐ Monday, March 31, 2014 will be a full instructional day for NPHS and middle school students. It will be an early dismissal day for elementary students, providing time for a limited number of elementary school parent/teacher conferences. This day was originally a day off for all students.
□ Wednesday, April 16, 2014 will now be a full day of instruction for all students. It was previously an early dismissal day for elementary, Northbridge and NPHS students and a full day for middle school students including sophomore orientation for 9th graders.
☐ Thursday, April 17, 2014 will now be an early dismissal day for elementary, Northbridge and NPHS students. Middle school students will have a full day of school including sophomore orientation for freshmen.
☐ Monday, April 21, 2014 will now be an instructional day for students. It was originally a day off for students and staff.
□ Tuesday, May 20, 2014 (Election Day) will now be an instructional day for students. It was originally a day off for students and an in-service day for staff. Please note that district administration and school staff will work with the board of elections to ensure the safety of our students on this day. Measures include deploying extra security staff and changing the location of polling sites within the schools.
□ Wednesday, June 18, 2014 , will now be the last day of school. The original last day for students was Tuesday, June 17, 2014. June 18 will be an early dismissal for all students and June 17 will be a full day.
