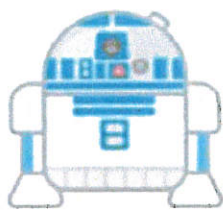
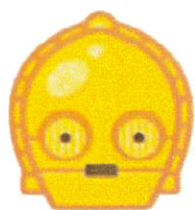

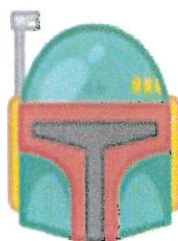

Olympic Day is **Friday, May 27, 2016**, with a rain date of Tuesday, May 31, 2016.

All guests will be permitted on the grounds with proper ID and parent/guardian consent.

Please utilize this pre-registration form or the online form, (<http://goo.gl/forms/mxKyrtwySq>) to let us know who will be attending. Be sure to include the names of all family members or friends over the age of 18 who will be joining you; this includes moms, dads, aunts, uncles, older siblings, etc.

The names will then be checked to see if they are in our Raptor system. If the name is already in the system, nothing more need to be done. **Any person that has not been scanned through Raptor will need to bring in their driver's license or state ID to have it scanned.** In an effort to have you arrive at the events on time, scanning can be done prior to Olympic Day.

General Nash staff will be there to register you and provide you with a wristband prior to attending the event. Once parents and guests arrive at the school, please be sure to go directly to the check in area to sign in. Please have your photo id ready.

Remember to come and register early if you will be attending the Opening Ceremonies. The registration tables will be open throughout the day for our guests to sign in. If you should need to enter the building, please sign in at the office as you would normally do.

Because of the size of the crowd that attended the event that was unexpectedly canceled on April 6, we are now hosting the event at Pennfield Middle School (726 Forty Foot Road Hatfield, PA) They will also answer questions during the evening. These amazing ladies, with the help of a representative from the Holocaust Museum in Philadelphia, tell their stories in a way that makes you feel as if you were there and showcases the horrors, but also the love and humanity of others in a way that will make you laugh, cry, and feel redemption of the human spirit.



We would love to have you join us. Both books are available for pre-sale so that you can read them before or after seeing them live and hearing the tale from their own perspectives. You will also learn how the book came to fruition which is an amazing story. The books are only available via this printer, so don't miss your opportunity to own one!

This is an important story to be shared but is definitely for mature audiences. 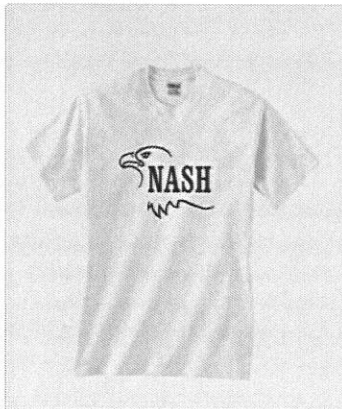
