



Dear Nash Families,

This year's **Olympic Day** is **Friday, June 6th** with a **rain date of June 9th**.

The day will consist of opening ceremonies, five stations in the morning, lunch/movie & five stations in the afternoon. Students in grades 1st through 6th and afternoon Kindergarten will receive a Popsicle at the end of the day provided by the Home and School Association. Morning kindergarten students will receive their Popsicle when they return to school on Monday. Students who choose to bring their own lunches are asked to use disposable items.

The students have been divided into five teams. By having 5 teams student participation can be increased. The colors of the teams are the Olympic flag colors (Red, Blue, Yellow, Green and Black (Gray)). Students are asked to wear their team's color to school on Olympic Day and **Sneakers**. For students on the Black team, who are concerned about the heat, a gray tee shirt is suggested. Although students are encouraged to wear the colors of their team, I understand that not everyone may have that particular color clothing. Consequently, students are not required to wear their team's color. It is suggested that students have sun screen applied before school. Hats are acceptable for protection. Children should dress in layers, as it can be cool in the morning and hot in the afternoon. Please have your son/daughter bring a water bottle with their name on it. Remind them they are the only ones that should be drinking out of their bottle.

Grade levels will stay together throughout the day. A schedule for the day is attached to help you follow your Olympic athlete(s) through out the day.

The main focus of Olympic Day is not winning and losing, but having fun. I hope that through Olympic Day the life skills of teamwork and sportsmanship can be reinforced. Although there is nothing wrong with wanting to win, students are reminded that the true winners are the ones who display the characteristics of being a "good sport".

With the cooperation of staff, families and students Olympic Day will be a success. I look forward to seeing you on June 6th!!
