




2nd Annual General Nash Elementary School March-a-Thon



GENERAL NASH PHYSICAL EDUCATION NORTH PENN SCHOOL DISTRICT

Dear Parents/Guardian,

Hello, and welcome to Nash's Physical Education program. In order to provide a safe and healthy experience, your child is required to be prepared with the following items every week so they may fully participate in the program.

All students

- Athletic sneakers with **LACES** (tied securely) or **VELCRO** (no slip-ons)
- T-shirt, sweatshirt or warm up jacket
- Shorts, sweatpants or warm up pants
- No jewelry

Grades 5 and 6

- Students may bring deodorant with them, but it can't be an aerosal spray.
 - 5th graders should come to school dressed for PE class and bring clothing to change into for the rest of the day
 - 6th graders should bring a t-shirt to change into for PE class

FEELING BLUE

If your child needs to be excused for one class, a written note from you will be accepted.

If your child is to be excused for more than one class, a **DOCTOR'S NOTE** is **Necessary**.
