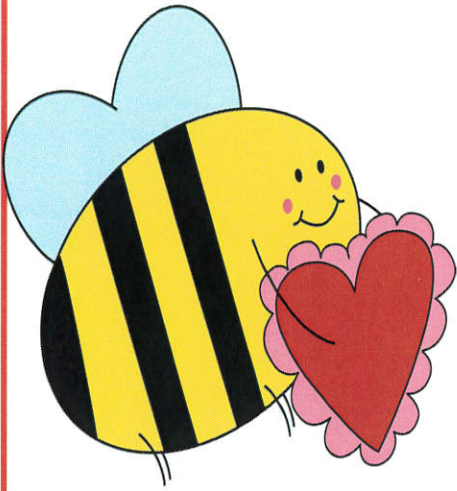
## Candy Gram Sale

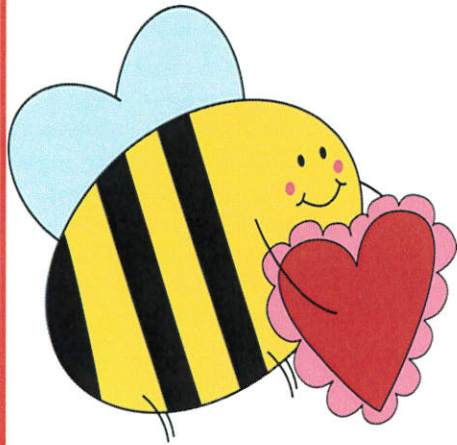

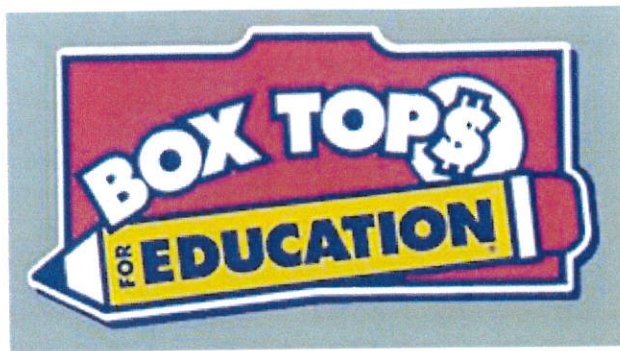



1. The class that collects the highest amount of Box Tops will get to choose their reward (from a predetermined list like movie time, PJ day, Wii dance party, extra recess, etc).

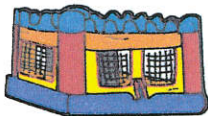

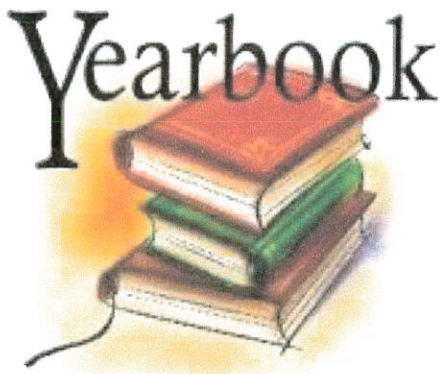
