Regarding: Sunscreen/bug spray procedure

Dear Parent(s) and Guardian(s),

Olympic Day is this coming Friday, May 26th and we would like to remind you of the procedure for applying sunscreen/bug spray to your children.

- Please apply sunscreen/bug spray before your child comes to school.
- If your child needs to re-apply the sunscreen/bug spray during the day:
We must have a signed note from the parent/guardian giving your child permission to self-apply the sunscreen/bug spray when needed. If the student is unable to self-apply you, as the parent/guardian, may re-apply in the afternoon.
The sunscreen/bug spray must be in the original container and not be expired.
- Many individuals have severe allergies to the ingredients in sunscreen/bug spray. Please talk with your child about the importance of not sharing their sun screen/bug spray with other students. Also, they should not apply another student's sunscreen/bug spray for them.

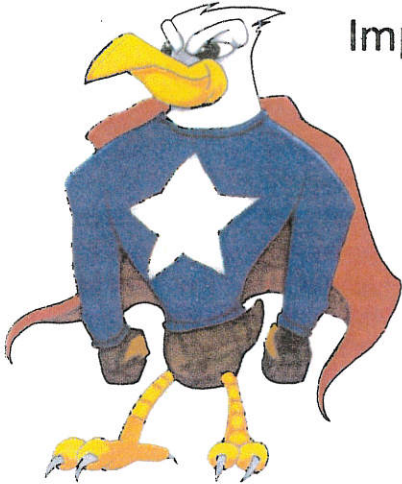

THE GENERAL NASH BRICK WALKWAY!

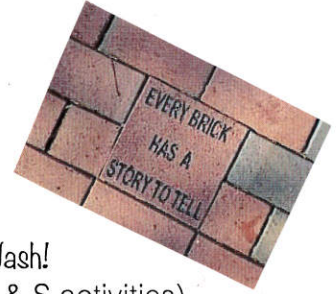
The brick walkway in front of General Nash is waiting for you to make your mark in the school's history!

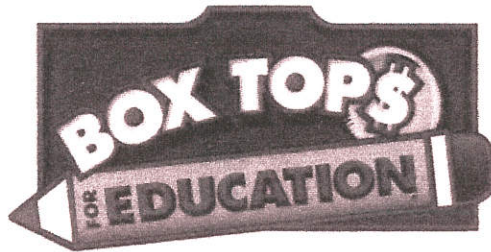
