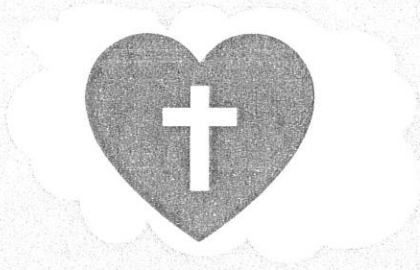

## 2017 – 2018 Nash Summary of Events

### Year long / monthly events

Dining Nights Out – dine out at specific restaurants each month and proceeds of the night will go to Nash

Spirit Days – the first Friday of each month is a Spirit Day. See calendar for monthly details.

Home & School Meetings – regular meetings held at Nash to keep parents informed of upcoming events and other goings on of the Home & School Association. Babysitting is available. Meeting dates are Sept 12, Nov 9, Feb 7, and May 10

### September

8 – Welcome Picnic – All families are welcome to attend a kick off to the school year. DJ, Crafts and food available for purchase.

19 – Back to School Night – Parents only event. Come out to meet your student's teacher and to see what they will be learning this year. There are 2 sessions for families with more than one student at Nash

22 – Coordinator / Room Parent Orientation – if you are interested in helping in your student's classroom during the year, you will be able to meet other room parents. Also, if you are coordinating an event this year you are invited to come to get information.

### October

4 – Walk to School Day – busses will drop all students off at Liberty Bell and Green Lane Roads and all students will walk to school with teacher supervision

20 – March a thon – The biggest fundraiser of the year. Students will raise money in the weeks before the event. All students will walk / run / march on an outside course.

31 – Halloween Parade – parents are invited to stand outside and watch the students parade around the parking lot

### November

13 – 17 – American Education Week – on specific days parents are invited in to watch their Student's class

16 – Mini Book Fair – Students visit the book fair during the day and families can visit at night

### December

9 – Holiday Shop / Breakfast with Frosty – all families are invited to shop. Helpers will be available to help the students shop and wrap their presents. Breakfast is available for purchase and Frosty is available for pictures. Students will also have an opportunity during the previous week during class.

22 – Holiday Sing-a-long – Students will assemble in the gym and have a sing-a-long. Parents are welcome to come and watch.

### January

TBD – Geography Bee – 4<sup>th</sup>- 6<sup>th</sup> graders compete against each other to answer Geography questions



## February

- 2 – Cake Walk Contest – all students are invited to make a cake (or two) Students will vote on the cakes during the day and prizes will be awarded for winners.
- 3 - Winter Carnival – All families are invited to come out. There will be games, crafts, food, Magician, prizes and a cake walk ( a musical chairs type game where the winner wins a cake from the cake contest) Ticket are available to purchase before and during carnival.
- 9 – Father / Daughter Dance – Fathers (or Father Figures) are invited to bring their daughters to a dance. There will be a DJ, crafts and food.
- 23 – Basketball Blast – 4<sup>th</sup> – 6<sup>th</sup> graders compete in a round robin basketball competition. All families are invited to come out and cheer the players on. All proceeds are used for the Nash Scholarship Fund which provides a 2 scholarships to graduating seniors who were Nash students.
- TBD – Math Night – all families are welcome to come out and play math type games.

## March

- 12-15 – Book Fair – Students are able to shop during their Library class for new books. There is a family night with an ice cream social on the 15<sup>th</sup> for parents to shop.
- 23 – Mother / Son Event – Mom’s (or mother figures) are invited to come out with their son’s for fun games and food.

## April

- 27 – Spring Zing – All families are invited to come to dance the night away. There is a DJ, snacks and prizes.
- TBD – Literacy Night – Families are invited to come to school and see students art work and writing. Some years we have had surprise readers, raffle prizes and book swaps.

## May

- 11 – Volunteer Lunch – Anyone who has volunteered during the year is invited to come and enjoy a Thank You lunch.
- 19 – Triathlon – Students in all elementary schools are invited to sign up to participate in a fun race of swimming, biking and running. This event takes place at the High School
- TBD – Olympic Day – Students are divided into teams and have a friendly competition with each other while having fun playing games outside all day.

## June

- 7 – Recognition Assembly – Parents are invited to come to the assembly and see students in all grades get various awards and recognitions.
- 8 – Moving Up Ceremony – Parents are invited to come see each grade “dance” their way to the next grade. Select students in each grade give speeches to let students know what they will be learning next year
- TBD – Lip Sync – 6<sup>th</sup> graders perform during the school day for the other grades, parents are invited to come to watch
